## Redwood City Caltrain and downtown shuttles

When SRWC opens, the existing Commute.org service will increase frequency to every 15 to 20 minutes thanks to funding from Stanford. Stanford Marguerite will provide midday service about every 30 minutes. We expect new shuttle schedules around February.

### Current shuttle hours:

6:15 a.m. to 9:30 a.m.

3:45 p.m. to 6:45 p.m.

### Anticipated Marguerite hours:

Between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m.

## When can SRWC employees purchase permits?

We expect SRWC parking permits to be available closer to employees' move-in dates. Please keep in mind that **virtual permits** are instantly available, so purchasing months in advance is not necessary or advisable, especially since moving schedules are subject to change.

Rather than traveling between campuses, consider working half or full days on the main campus when necessary.

For employees who require space to work before or after meetings, the **SRWC Business Center** in the Bambi modular will serve as a touchdown space. It's located at **320 Panama Mall**.

available in the near term. New features, such as permit types and pricing, require more time to develop. In the meantime, here are some options to reduce parking costs:

By joining the **Commute Club** and **purchasing daily permits**, eligible SRWC commuters can receive up to \$300 a year in Clean Air Cash. For example, purchase 10 daily C-type permits per month, and Clean Air Cash could reduce your permit cost to \$27.50 instead of \$34 per month.

Another option is Scoop to carpool on a day-to-day basis. **One Stanford commuter has made \$100 a week** carpooling with Scoop!
