### **Sustainable Transportation**

#### **Take Transit**

- Free Caltrain Go Pass, VTA SmartPass, and SamTrans pass
- Free shuttle services between SRWC and the Redwood City Caltrain station

#### **Share the Ride**

- Free 'C' parking permits for carpools
- Free vanpool parking and 100% subsidized vanpool lease
- Free ridematching services with Stanford subsidies for riders and drivers using Scoop

#### **Ride a Bike**

- Secure bike storage, bike safety repair stands, and sample bike routes
- Mobile bicycle service on site once a month and discounts on bike helmets and folding bikes at the Campus Bike Shop

### **Parking at SRWC**

#### **Drive and Carpool**

- Virtual parking permits and online ordering: **[transportation.stanford.edu/order](https://transportation.stanford.edu/order)**
- 'C-SRWC' permit holders can park in 'C' spaces on main campus (and 'A' and 'C' main campus permit holders can park in commuter spaces at SRWC)
- Consider carpooling (or vanpooling) for a free carpool parking permit and additional incentives
