As of 2020, bike registration will be only available online and managed by the Department of Public Safety (DPS) through the Project 529 Garage bicycle registration program at project529.com/garage . HOW TO KEEP YOUR BIKE SECURE
Please refer to our How to Lock Your Bike infographic for tips on how to securely lock your bike. <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Always use a bike rack in the bike cage. Lock your bike with a U-shaped lock, not a cable lock that can be easily cut.• Lock the frame and wheels to the bike rack.• Do not leave valuables or items of value on the bike inside the bike cage.• Do not park your bike and block entryway.• Report any security issues to Stanford Public Safety: 650.723.9633• For emergencies, dial 911, or use the blue emergency tower to contact SUPD.

IF YOUR BIKE IS STOLEN OR LOST
At the main campus: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Report a stolen bike to Stanford Public Safety immediately: 650.723.9633.• To report a theft or other crime in progress call 9-911 on campus phones, 911 from other phones.
At Stanford Redwood City: <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Report a stolen bike to Redwood City Police Department immediately by calling 650.780.7118 or by filing a theft report. Alternatively, you can call the SRWC call center at 650.723.SRWC (9972). To report a theft or other crime in progress call 911.
