

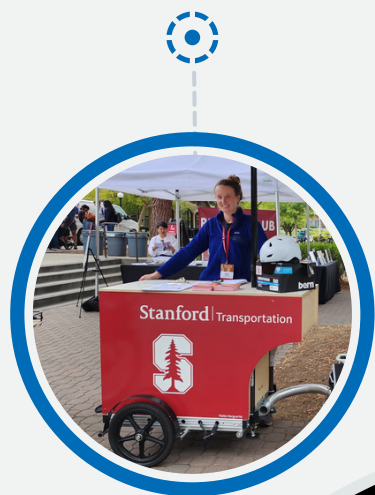


STANFORD BICYCLE PROGRAM
